CACTUS HIGH SCHOOL PARKING AWARENESS STATEMENT

To ensure safe and orderly use of the school parking lot, the following procedures will be observed:

- _____ • **Pedestrians ALWAYS have the right of way on campus.**
- _____ • **Loitering in the CHS parking lot is prohibited during the school day.** This means do not “hangout” in your car or in the parking lot between the hours of 6:30am-3:00pm.
- _____ • Students are to park **ONLY** in their assigned numbered space. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action. Students are **NOT** allowed to park in visitor/staff areas.
- _____ • **ALL** vehicles must be registered and display on the rearview mirror a **2025 parking permit**. If you need to update a vehicle, please see the Bookstore immediately!
- _____ • Parking permits are non-transferable. If you are caught giving your permit to another student, your privileges will be immediately revoked.
- _____ • PUSD (Peoria Unified School District) and Cactus HS are **NOT** responsible for any theft or vandalism. The parking lot is a convenience facility provided by the school. Students use it at their own risk. The school is not responsible for theft or damage. Students are encouraged to **ALWAYS** lock their cars.
- _____ • **All** vehicles entering the CHS Parking Lot are subject to search by school authorities and/or law enforcement personnel. Search may be conducted without a warrant for any reasonable purpose. Following notice of intent to search, the vehicle will **NOT** be permitted to leave the premises without permission. Students will face disciplinary action for any real/toy weapons or contraband found during a search of their vehicle.
- _____ • Driving in a manner that is deemed unsafe or hazardous by the staff may be grounds for immediate revocation of **ALL** campus driving/parking privileges. **Speed limit in the parking lot is 10 MPH, and students MUST use designated driving lanes to navigate through the parking lot. Cutting across empty spaces is neither safe nor permitted.**
- _____ • Drivers involved in accidents in the CHS parking lot are responsible for contacting local authorities (**if the campus SRO is not available**) and insurance companies.
- _____ • **“3 Strike Rule” (warning ticket, warning sticker, vehicle boot)** applies to **ANY** student not in compliance of the above rules and regulations.

To be registered and to receive a parking permit a student must:

1. Possess a **VALID** Arizona driver’s license. Show proof of **CURRENT** insurance. Show **CURRENT** vehicle(s) registration.
2. Be a 3rd or 4th year high school student. Space and availability will be factors to determine 2nd year student permit distribution for 2nd semester of the current school year.
3. Be paid/cleared on student account fees/fines.
4. Hang the parking permit on the rearview mirror, facing out. You **MUST** have a tag on a registered vehicle to park in the student parking area **Monday through Friday between 6:30am-3:00pm**.

We have read and understand each of the above policies and guidelines for seeking a parking permit. We understand that non-compliance with ANY of the guidelines mentioned above may result in temporary or permanent suspension of parking privileges.
