The Seal of Arts Proficiency Application Process

Step 1 Completion of Coursework



 A minimum of 4 credits in one artistic discipline: (dance, music, theatre, visual arts or media arts).

• OR

 A minimum of 3 credits in one artistic discipline, and 1 qualifying separate artistic discipline.

• AND

• A final GPA of 3.0 or 4.0 (A or B) in each qualifying arts course.

Step 2 Extra Curricular Activities



- Students graduating in school year 2025-2026 must complete <u>a</u> <u>minimum of 80 hours</u> over a student's four years in High School
- The Office of Arts Education defines an extracurricular activity as any arts participation above and beyond the regularly scheduled school day for which students are NOT receiving course credit. Activities may be school-sponsored or take place outside of the school day or building.

Step 3 Capstone Project

- What is a Capstone?
- A demonstration of the culmination of student's knowledge from all of their coursework
- An application of real-world skills and experience
- Students are encouraged to connect to community or outsideof-school learning environment
- A personal exploration of interests and individual goals
- A representation of their Artistic literacy: Create, Perform/Present/Produce, Connect, and Respond through an artistic project
