ACTIVITY TRAVEL RELEASE

According to the "Travel Procedures for Students" portion of the Peoria Unified School District Student/Parent Athletic Handbook, **"All athletes are required to use district-provided transportation. The only exception is in the occasional situation where parents need to provide transportation for their child following an event... It should be done only when absolutely essential, and not as a matter of routine..."** When parents have a particular need to provide transportation, the following requirements must be met:

- They must obtain written approval from the school athletic director no later than the day prior to the date of the event.
- They must communicate directly with the head coach concerning their intentions and provide the head coach a copy of the written approval prior to the team's departure for the event.
- The head coach will allow the athlete to leave the event only with his/her parent or guardian.
- The head coach may adopt and enforce more strict requirements if and when they deem it necessary, as approved by the athletic director."
